

FREE WORKSHOP FOR ARTS ORGANIZATIONS

The Arts Build Communities (ABC) grant program is designed to provide support for arts projects that broaden access to arts experiences, address community quality of life issues through the arts, or enhance the sustainability of asset-based cultural enterprises. The Greater Nashville Regional Council (GNRC) is designated to administer the ABC program on behalf of the Tennessee Arts Commission for Davidson, Rutherford, Sumner, Trousdale, Williamson, and Wilson Counties.
